Owen Hofecker presented Ordinance 505: AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FERNDALE, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING AND ENACTING A SERVICE CHARGE FOR FALSE FIRE ALARMS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF FERNDALE.

A motion was made by Cindy Dom to accept and pass Ordinance 505, seconded by Connie Hobbs. A roll call vote was taken with all members voting yes. The motion carried.

# FERNDALE FIREMAN'S ASSOC. REPORT

Owen Hofecker said he would like to thank the fire association for their donation of \$6,000.00 to the borough.

### STREETS AND PROPERTY

Sean said that he ordered 75 tons of salt and has to order 75 more to meet the contract requirements with Costars.

Eric Baumbaugh said they went down and looked at the bathroom doors at the recreation park. For now, they are going to try and fix it by replacing the hinges.

Eric Baumbaugh said they would like to purchase tarps for the trucks. Nancy did look into it and said they would be able to use funds from liquid fuels to purchase the tarps.

#### SEWER/SEWER PROJECT REPORT

Frank DiLoreto was present from EADS.

One pressure test was completed in January.

Hystone Avenue Sewer Rehabilitation: EADS has submitted a final invoice and will begin the grant closeout.

Station St Walkway Rehabilitation Project: Due to existing utility concerns, the bidding for the project was delayed to coordinate with Peoples Natural Gas and GJWA to relocate their lines from underneath the existing sidewalk. Once utility coordination is determined, bidding will be scheduled. Fall construction is the current goal.

Rigby Park Improvements Project: DCNR grant was awarded \$170,000.00 to the borough. This includes replacing the playground equipment, pavilion roofs, and adding ADA walkways to the pavilions and playground. DCNR scheduled a pre-con call on Feb 17<sup>th</sup> at 11:00am to discuss the project and prepare the grant agreement. The grant agreement between the DCNR and Ferndale needs to be executed prior to design beginning.

Local Share Account Statewide Program & GTRP Program: Announcement for the grants is anticipated to be March 2023.

PennDot MTF Grant Application: Submitted grant for the Rigby Park Pedestrian Lighting Project. Announcement for the grant is anticipated to be April 2023.

DCED Small Water and Sewer Grants: Grants will be submitted for the following projects: Goucher St Storm Sewer Rehabilitation & Stormwater improvements and Manhole Rehabilitation. Announcement for the grant has not been determined.

West Hills Regional Stormwater Meeting: Westmont Borough and the City of Johnstown have scheduled a meeting to discuss the creation of a stormwater authority with the City of Johnstown, Westmont Borough, Southmont Borough, Brownstown Borough, Upper Yoder Township, Lower Yoder Township and Ferndale Borough. Meeting is scheduled for noon, Friday February 24<sup>th</sup> at Central Park Complex.

#### TAX COLLECTOR'S REPORT

Tax Collector's Report was presented for January 2023. No money was collected in January.
