SEWER/SEWER PROJECT REPORT

Two pressure tests were completed in July.

Ferndale Ave Sidewalk Rehabilitation Project: The project was advertised on July 21st. A prebid meeting was conducted on 8/7/2025 where contractors asked questions and walked the job site. The bid opening is scheduled for Thursday August 21, 2025 at 10am.

Station St Phase 2 Project: A Merante Contracting Inc has been sending submittals for approval. Ferndale Borough Council need to decide if they want the new handrail for the steps/sidewalk to be battleship gray or black to match the handrail on Station St.

DCED LSA 2023 Grant: The cancelled check for the grant was sent to the DCED to close out the project.

DCED LSA 2024 Grant: Grant announcement is anticipated for September of 2025.

DCED MTF 2025 Grant: An application will be submitted for the sidewalk between Vickroy and Ferndale Avenue. A grant announcement date has not been determined at this time.

TAX COLLECTOR'S REPORT

Tax Collector's Report was presented for July 2025. The amount collected in July was \$2,159,26.
